

We Need Your Help at FSR!

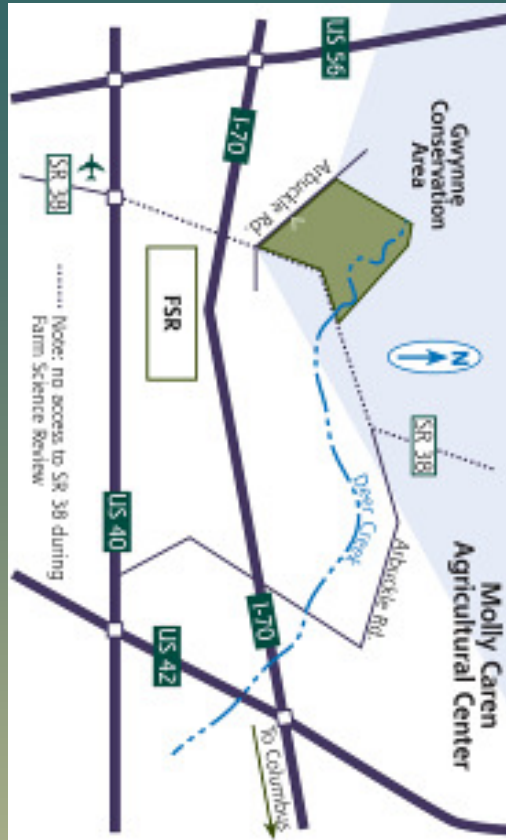
Below are some examples of what Gwynne volunteers do during the Farm Science Review:

Wagon Tour Guide: Volunteers will narrate the shuttle ride around the Gwynne, describing the conservation demonstration areas and other Gwynne features.

Attendance Count: We have come to depend on the attendance information you have gathered over the past two years. This year we will be counting visitors as they enter the Gwynne at the shuttle stop on the corner of Arbuckle Road and SR 38.

Visitor Information Booth: We will have a booth located at the entrance to the GCA. Volunteers will field questions and orient visitors as to where to find the programs, experts or exhibits they need.

Amphitheatre Monitor: We will need volunteers to staff our presentation amphitheatres during the course of each day. Volunteers will assist presenters with any needs they may have, introduce the speaker and make an attendance count of those attending.
